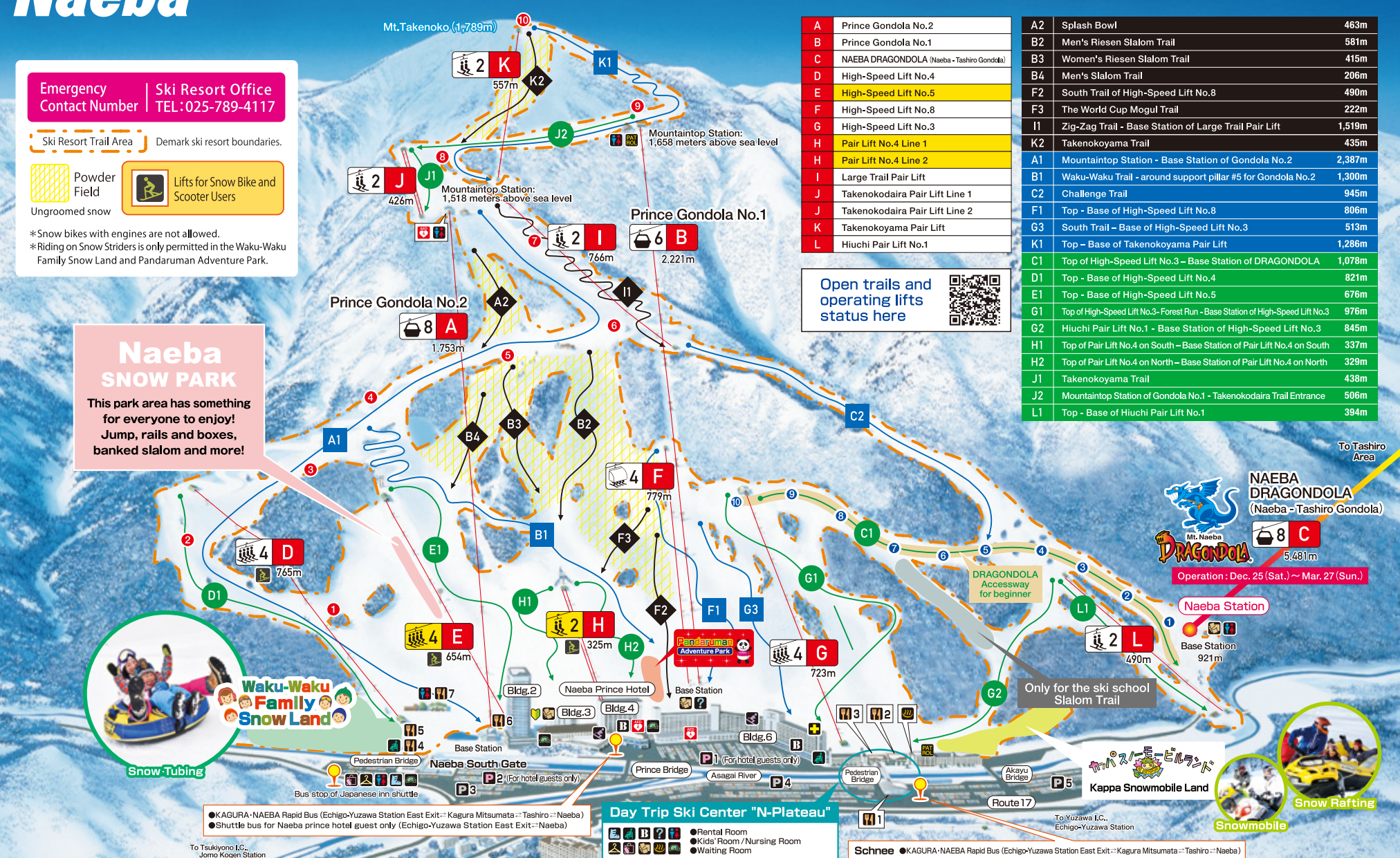

Requests for Naeba Ski Resort visitors who venture outside (backcountry) the Trail Supervising Area Boundary

- Leave the boundaries at the designated spots to avoid mishaps. ● Remove your skis when going outside the boundaries to avoid leaving ski-trails which may cause a mishap.
- Make sure to submit a designated mountain climbing registration form each time to your nearest patrolman station. (We'll be in charge of keeping them for the police.) ● When going into the backcountry, please make sure you are fully equipped with the proper gear.
- Skiers will take responsibility for their activities when outside the boundaries. ● It is recommended that skiers carry a device for determining latitude/longitude in the event of an emergency.
- A communication device should be kept on hand in the event of an emergency. ● For the latest weather and snowfall information, please check the Naeba Ski Resort website and our social media. ● Emergency search and rescue charges will be fully paid at your own expense.
- In the event of an emergency, please inform your name, contact address and number, color of your ski gear, the location where you went outside the boundary, your present physical condition (mishap, injury, snow-slide) and your latitude/longitude. The police will be informed of the situation and we will act in accordance to their instructions. Thank you for your cooperation in helping prevent accidents.
